

Woman charged in rape case

A woman accused of providing a schoolgirl from northern Namibia as a sexual partner for two men in the Okahandja district has denied the charges at the start of her trial in the Windhoek High Court. [The Namibian](#) reports that Tuufilwa Jonas faces **four counts of rape, one count of attempted rape and three charges of human trafficking**. Jonas, who is being represented by Milton Engelbrecht, was arrested in November 2015. She has been in custody since then. State Advocate Felistas Shikerete-Vendura is prosecuting.
