

Top photographer charged with trespassing in Kenya

The chief photographer for Agence France-Presse (AFP) in east Africa has appeared in court charged with trespassing on a property belonging to President Uhuru Kenyatta's family. Japanese photographer Yasuyoshi Chiba was arrested on Friday afternoon at a farm belonging to the Brookside dairy company which is owned by Kenyatta's family. A report on the [News24](#) site notes that **he had planned to photograph the company logo** after the opposition National Super Alliance named Brookside as one of three companies its supporters should boycott as part of a 'resistance' campaign following disputed presidential elections.
