## China eases price controls on services, commodities

Government-set controls on the cost of air and rail passenger and cargo transportation in China will be lifted as part of a drive to deregulate prices and improve competition, the country's National Development and Reform Commission (NDRC) has announced, according to a report on the Out-Law.com site.

The changes are among eight sets of regulations lifting price controls on 24 different commodities and services published on the NDRC's. The documents cover tobacco pricing, rail transport, civil aviation, ports, professional services, local services and explosive materials for civil use; and the changes took effect in November and December 2014.
