* **A senior lecturer at Unisa has apologised for ‘embarrassing herself’ after lashing out at National Student Financial Aid Scheme (NSFAS) recipients at the institution on social media.** Tracey McKay said she regretted her actions and apologised to everyone who had been harmed by her comments on Twitter. McKay's tweets were in response to user Roman Cabanac who had asked how textbook sales could fall if NSFAS gave students R5 000 to spend on books.
