Brazil's Lula linked to Equatorial Guinea graft

Brazil's Attorney-General has opened an inquiry looking into allegations that former President Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva received donations for helping a Brazilian company get business in Equatorial Guinea. **Legalbrief** reports that **Lula is already serving a 12-year jail term**. He was arrested in April and convicted on charges of money laundering and passive corruption. **BBC News** reports that he is now accused of receiving bribes in return for brokering deals between Equatorial Guinea and a Brazilian construction company ARG.
