

## Nairobi nanny convicted of manslaughter

A Kenyan caregiver has been jailed for three years for killing a child who suffered from cerebral palsy. Jackline Murunga had been working at the home of Miriam Ndung'u in Nairobi as a caregiver to two children. A report on the [eNCA](#) site notes that a pathologist's report revealed that **the victim died on 27 May due to head injuries from blunt force**. High Court Judge Stella Mutuku sentenced her on one count of manslaughter. At the end of her sentence, Murunga will be placed on supervised probation for two years.
